An American Cardinal: Biography of Cardinal Timothy Dolan

Christina Boyle tells all about Dolan from his upbringing in Missouri to his role in the election of Pope Francis. The book does a great job of telling all the little personal stories of the people he touched throughout his life. The best part was all the difficult decisions Dolan had to make as a bishop, especially during the clerical sex abuse crisis.



Saint of the Month **Junipero Serra, July 1st**

Born on November 24, 1713 in Petra, Spain to peasant parents. He showed an early interest in the Franciscan order and joined it at the age of 16. He proved to be an intelligent priest and would later teach Philosophy at de Convento San Francisco, Spain. In 1748 he moved to America to conduct missionary work, and was instantly noted for his humility. While at the Spanish missions, he was known to teach the natives with passion, help improve their plight, and almost always took their side over the local, corrupt Spanish authorities. In 1767 he was appointed president of modern day California missions. He founded over half a dozen missions including what would later become San Francisco and San Diego. Up until his death in 1784, he constantly inspected the missions and looked after his converts. He was Beatified in 2015, but many called him a bigot and destroyed many of his statues in 2020.
