Saint of the Month

St. Albert the Great

Albert was born in 1200 in the town of Lauingen, Bavaria. He attended the University of Padua and in 1223 he received a vision of the Virgin Mary that inspired him to join the Dominican order. He traveled around becoming a lecturer and later a professor of Theology at the University of Paris. One of his students was the great Thomas Aquinas who would become a great saint. In 1259 St. Albert, along with Thomas Aquinas and others, participated in the General chapter of the Dominicans, which developed a program of study in philosophy. This later developed into the Angelicum, one of most impressive theological colleges today. He would serve a time as bishop, administrator of the Dominicans, Crusade preacher, author and papal mediator. He died in 1280, was canonized in 1622 by Pope Gregory XVI, and in 1931 was declared a Doctor of the church. Info gathered from Catholic Online.

Popes, Emperors and Elephants by Roy Peachy

In this short 200 page book, Roy Peachy describes nearly a thousand years of history, talking about everything from Pompeii, history of the cucumber, how the number zero arose, and stories about a few elephants.
