Saint of the Month Pope Pius V April 30th

Born Antonio Ghislieri in Bosco, Italy, in 1504 to a poor peasant family. In 1518, Pope Pius joined the Dominicans as a friar and ten years later he became a priest lecturing at the University at Pavia. Throughout this time he showed an unflinching zeal for the faith, cracked down on corruption, and lived simply. Pope Paul IV and Pope Pius IV entrusted him with many tasks including inquisitor general for all Christendom. In 1566, he was elected Pope and took the name of Pius the V. As Pope he did much to decrease corruption and combat Protestantism. He reduced papal luxuries, reformed the Roman liturgy, and insured good priests would properly implement the Council of Trent. In 1571, he organized the Holy League to combat the rising Muslim Ottoman Empire. When the Christian and Muslim fleets met at the Battle of Lepanto, Pius encouraged all Christians to pray the rosary for victory, they indeed won. He died the next year and was canonized in 1712.
