## Saint of the Month St. Isidore of Seville -April 4th

St. Isidore was born sometime in the 500's AD in Spain to a family of saints. Both of his brothers, Leander and Fulgentius, and sister, Florentina, were saints and leaders of the church. Despite this, Isidore's childhood was rough as his older brother Leander often times beat him to focus on his studies. Still despite this rough relationship Isidore forgave his brothers and worked with him in many projects. Isidore is known above all for his love of learning and his greatest achievement was establishing a seminary in every diocese in Spain and wrote several books in Grammar, Astronomy, History, and Theology. After Leander's death he took over as bishop of Seville and was known as a compassionate bishop who cared for the poor and attempted to convert heretics. He died in 636 A.D. and is declared a doctor of the church.
