Saint of the Month

St. Benedict of Nursia - July 11th

St. Benedict and his twin sister, St. Scholastica, were born in Norsica, Italy to noble parents in 480AD. Like most young men of his day Benedict was sent to school to learn rhetoric but found the atmosphere unappealing and he left to become a hermit. As a hermit he had many important battles with the devil. In one incident he dropped himself on a thorn bush to save his soul. As a hermit he was so holy that a group of monks wanted him to be their leader. He warned them that he would be very strict with them as their leader and when he proved just that they tried to poison him which he miraculously survived. He tried with another group of monks in Subiaco but was forced to flee by another hermit. He tried for a third time and was successful in Monte Casino, Italy where he founded a monastery with his sister, Scholastica, who was a nun. At this monastery he wrote "Benedict's rule" which laid the foundation for the Benedictines and still continues to this day. He was known for the depth of his prayer, biblical studies, and alms to the poor. St. Benedict died on March 21, 543AD and is the patron saint of Europe and students.
