The Abolition of Man
By C.S. Lewis

Alright, technically not a catholic book since Lewis was Anglican, I feel this book is really good and has enough catholic messages to allow it. Lewis, almost seventy years ago, warned of certain intellectuals that tried to discredit true objective values. Arguing that getting rid of true Christian objective values would lead to dangers that are clear in the world today. The book is only forty pages and very enjoyable to read so a definite recommendation if anyone wants to understand how the world got to the state it's in today.

Saint of the Month
Vasyl Velichkovsky

Born in 1903 in Stanislaviv (Austria-Hungary) he became a priest in the Ukrainian Greek Catholic Church, an eastern church in communion with Rome, in 1925. In 1945 he was arrested by the soviet secret police ,NKVD, for preaching the gospel, he was sentenced to death but was commuted to ten years in a prison camp. He was released in 1955 and was ordained bishop of Moscow in 1963. In 1969 he was sent to a work camp again, he was then exiled from the country in 1972 and died in 1973 in Winnipeg, Canada from injuries he received due to prison torture. Before he died he said, "The prisons and camps ruined my health and my strength, but this was my fate; the Lord God placed this cross on my shoulders." His body remained incorruptible for 30 years and was declared a saint in 2001 for his martyrdom,
