Saint of the Month

St.Charles Lwanga and the Ugandan martyrs - June 3rd

Christianity came into the kingdom of Uganda in the 1870's by the Society of the Missionaries of Africa or White Fathers. One of the converts was Joseph Mkasa a steward at the court of King Mawanga. King Mawanga was a violent man and was a known pedophile but Joseph was able to save many boys from his desires. Joseph was killed for speaking against the king so Charles Lwanga took over caring for converts in the kings court and defending the boys the king wanted. However, in 1886 King Mawanga found out that Charles and other catechumens were keeping boys from him so he ordered Charles and his converts to be put to death. The group, which included many Protestants, were sent on a 37 mile truck ride to the place of their execution. They passed a missionary home of the White Fathers who gave them absolution as they passed. After a couple days in prison the 24 martyrs were wrapped in reed mats and burned alive. The missionaries were kicked out of the country until King Mwanga died. When they returned they found thousands ready to be baptized based on these heroic souls.
