**Saint of the Month
St. Phillip Neri- May 26th**

Born in Florence in 1515 as one of four children Phillip Neri was known to always be cheerful and obedient. When he was 18 years old he went to work with relatives at San Germano and had a mystical vision, soon afterwards he set out for Rome. While there, Phillip lived as a hermit in an ascetic life. After a couple of years of this lifestyle and studying he realized he needed to reinvigorate the faith in Rome. He would stand in the middle of the public square to convince people to strengthen their faith and often led them to service of others. His most famous question was “Well brothers, when shall we begin to do good?” In 1548 he helped found the Confraternity of the Most Holy Trinity which aided poor men to eat and expand their faith. In 1551 he was ordained to the priesthood and twenty four years later founded the Congregation of the Priest of the Oratory to help deepen the faith of others. He was called as an advisor to Popes, Kings and Saints all the while aiding the poor. He lived until 80 years old and was warned by a premonition of his imminent death. He said this before he died, “Last of all, we must die.” He was canonized in 1622 and is the patron saint of Rome, U.S. special forces, humor, and joy.
