

## Saint of the month

### Saint Gregory the Great: September 3rd

Saint Gregory was born in 540 AD in Rome to a Noble Patrician family. During his youth he saw Italy ravaged by plague and Barbarian invasions. At first pursuing a political career within Byzantine empire as prefect of Rome, after his father's death decided to convert his families estate and became an abbot. In 579 AD he was appointed ambassador to Constantinople to request aid from the Lombard invasions but his request was ignored. In 590 at the death of Pelagius the Second, he was declared pope by acclamation in which he was personally embarrassed by. As Pope he was known for his immense contributions, including sending

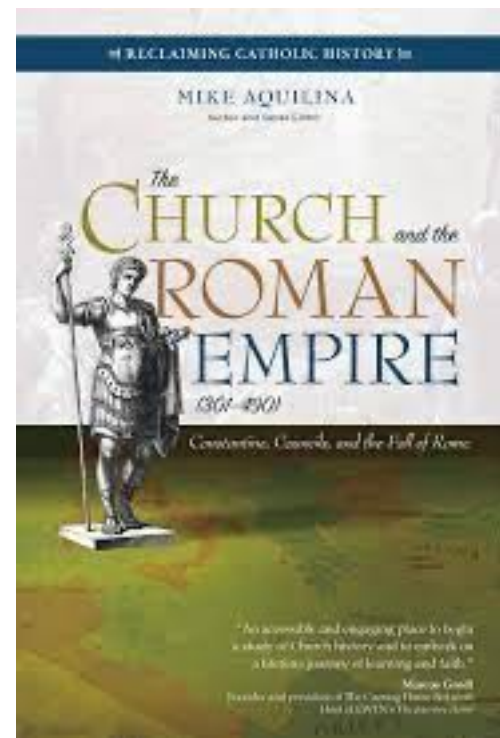
Missionaries to Britain, reform the mass, Helped establish Gregorian chant which bears his name, and his incredible contribution to feeding the poor literally seating dozens of them at his own table. He died on March 12th 604AD and was immediately proclaimed a saint. He is the patron of Musicians, Singers, Students, and Teachers. Info gotten from Catholic online.
