# Saint of the Month St.Padre Pio -September 23rd

Due to the recent movie about Padre Pio (and Shia LaBeouf's conversion after portraying the saint) I thought this be would be a very appropriate book. Padre Pio was born as Francesco Forgione on May 25th, 1887 in Pietrelcina, Italy to a devout yet poor peasant family. Pio already knew since the age of 5 that he wanted to serve the Lord as a priest and displayed the ability to see angels and speak directly with Jesus and Mary. Pio expressed this desire to his parents at the age of 10 and they went to see if he could join the local Capuchin friars but due to poor schooling didn't join until 5 years later and took the name Pio. Throughout his life he suffered from poor health and often had to remain home throughout his life. On September 20th in 1916 when hearing confession he found he developed a stigmata on his hands and feet. Due to this and his levitating ability he won fame far and wide and thousands came to see him, including a young John Paul II. At first, the Vatican didn't want Pio to have too much publicity since they didn't know if it was real, but after it was proven true the Vatican gave him support.
